Term 3 Outing

Greetings! The Term 3 school outing promises to be very exciting. Our students will have the opportunity to practise in a fun way the safety concepts learnt during their life readiness lessons.

Details of the outing are as follow:

Date: 30 August 2006 (Wednesday).
Attire: Pathlight PE Attire (Blue T-shirt and shorts)
Things to bring: Water bottle, Stationery, Cap, Snacks and Money.

There will be 2 outings taking place simultaneously:

All **Primary 2 to Secondary 4, Edison and Einstein classes** will visit the Road Safety Park at East Coast Park from 8.30-1 pm. The objective is to allow students to practise the road safety concepts learnt during life readiness lessons. Some activities will include:

- Road Safety Quiz
- Go-karting
- Cycling

For students going to the Road Safety Park, please let us know if your child can cycle on a 2-wheel bicycle independently so that we can plan a comprehensive programme to ensure that all students are grouped appropriately.

All **Track 1, P1, Mozart, Newton and Beethoven classes** will visit the Ang Mo Kio Fire Station from 8.30am-11.30 pm. The objective is to allow students to practise the fire safety concepts learnt during life readiness lessons. Some activities will include:

- Tour of the fire station
- Demonstration of Fire fighting
- Experimenting with fire fighting equipment & fire fighting vehicles like the “red rhino”, “platform ladder” and “fire fight”

Some students may be identified by their class teachers as requiring intensive support during outing especially for safety reasons. Hence, you may be approached by the teacher to either accompany your child or send your helper to support your child during the outing. Please support the teachers.

We may be contacting parents to help us out as volunteers. We seek your understanding that not all interested parties will be selected as we only require a limited number of volunteers due to logistics and cost reasons.
