PARTICIPATE IN SHARE-A-MEAL COLLABORATION TO HELP THE NEEDY

The Share-a-Meal event is a fund raising event organized by the MILK Organisation. The event aims to raise funds to help students whose families are in a crisis as a result of a recent death of a breadwinner or a sudden illness or accident in the family.

MILK (Mainly I love kids) is one of our most valuable partners. It is a non-profit organisation which has supported a number of Pathlighters from the low income families by providing financial assistance over and above school fee subsidy for school expenses such as school bus transport, school textbooks, uniform and holiday enrichment programmes.

We would like to invite your child to participate in the Share-a-Meal event. During the event, they will be working alongside volunteers from the Police Academy. Their responsibilities include the following:

We would appreciate it if you could submit the attached consent form to the class teacher by **5 February 2007 (Monday)**.

If your child is participating, please help to ensure that your child has pocket money/food for lunch. Teachers will be taking their lunch break as well and will not be available to look after your child before the session begins. Please arrange for support for students who are not independent during their lunch time.
