PATHLIGHT CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (CCA) PROGRAMME

We will be starting our CCA Programme on **Friday, 29 June 2007**.

As a reminder, please note the following CCA practices, which are in line with mainstream schools:

- The CCA programme is only for students who are in Primary 4-5, Secondary 1-3 and Track 3 classes (Einstein and Edison).
- Primary 6 students are exempted from the CCA programme in view of their PSLE remedial lessons. They will commence CCA immediately after PSLE.

Timing:

- CCA will no longer be conducted after school hours.
- Timing will be from **12 – 12:50pm**.
- There will be no CCA on 20 July (Racial Harmony Day), 10 August (National Day holiday) and 31 August (Teachers' Day Celebrations).

Activity:

CCA forms part of your child's holistic education in Pathlight. To provide students with an all-rounded CCA experience, all students involved will continue to rotate through physical, social and mental development activities, as well as, community involvement projects (CIP) throughout the year.
