## **Parents' Consent**

- a) A full ride around the Flyer will last 30 minutes, and it is not possible to get off the Flyer halfway through the ride.
- b) Although completely encased in see-through glass, students will be in a confined space with about 28 persons. The ride will not be suitable for students who are claustrophobic.
- c) The Flyer stands at a height of 165-metre-tall. The ride will not be suitable for students who are afraid of heights.

The School will have teachers and staff to support this outing, and will take the necessary precautions to ensure safety of our students.
