Synopsis: Featuring 19 dancers (b-boys and b-girls) from B-Boys Theatre, a renowned dance-theatre company from Korea, specialising in new wave hip-hop dance, B-Boyz is unique as it combines elements from both the arts and street culture, and will be very popular amongst youths in Singapore as it also features infectious hip-hop music. It is a new concept in performing arts and has drawn considerable attention world-wide. It played to full houses in Korea and at the 2007 Edinburgh Fringe Festival. After Singapore, the show will tour America, Japan, China and Spain.

The 80-minute (no intermission) show has no dialogue, relying only on the music and the dance moves, as well as an onstage spontaneous dance competition. Audiences will get to see some of the best break-dancing routines in the world, including head spins, which are very difficult to execute.
