CCA Programme details:

CCA	Brief Description
Speech & Drama	The curriculum provides instruction to students in articulation, voice projection, facial expression, body language/gestures. It develops them to have confidence and poise for public speaking as well as effective social and communication skills.
Inline Skating	This activity aims to hone students' psycho-motor skills. It also aims to expose students to a physical leisure activity.

Students can choose to wear their PE attire for Inline Skating lessons. All skating equipment will be provided by the coach. Students can also opt to bring their own skating equipment.


