CCA PROGRAMMES COMMENCING IN TERM 3 WEEK 4

We have just received MOE's latest H1N1 advisory that stipulates that all schools can now commence CCA from next week. This is with the exception of all graduating classes, as a precautionary measure advised by MOE. (Eg, all Primary 6 classes, Sec 4NTb and Sec 5NA).

Due to the cancellations of CCA sessions from Term 3 Week 1-3, the School has reviewed the co-payment fee by parents. We are happy to let you know that as a show of support, the School has decided to bear the remaining CCA costs until end of this year.

The CCA programmes have been carefully selected by the School and cater to youth interests. All programmes will be conducted by qualified and specialized professionals, who have undergone ASD strategies training by our Autism Consultant.

CCA programmes for Semester 2 are:

CCA Activity	Brief Description	Payable Fees
Art Club <i>(New)</i>	The art program aims to introduce students to basic sculpting techniques and installation works. It provides them with hands on experience and understanding of different visual art forms.	School will absorb for Semester 2
Percussions <i>(Existing)</i>	The program introduces basic musical notations and emphasizes ensemble techniques and aural skills. The skill achieved will encourage learners to listen to each other and work cohesively as a team. At later stages students will be exposed to percussion instruments from various parts of the world and be taught proper drum playing techniques.	
Outdoor Club <i>(Existing)</i>	The program aims to expose and equip students to outdoor skills and activities. The outdoor skills include first-aid, camp craft, topography, and planning an outdoor trip.

Students participating in Art Club and Outdoor Club are advised to put on their PE attire for their CCAs.

All CCA activities will be conducted on **Fridays, from 2.30pm – 4pm**. There will be no CCA during the Continuous and Semester Assessments weeks.
