Dear Parents/Guardians

SCHOOL REMAINS VIGILANT AND WILL KEEP UP PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES AGAINST H1N1

This letter is to update parents on how we are managing the H1N1 situation in our school.

The H1N1 virus may become more prevalent in the coming weeks and we will continue to keep up with the necessary precautionary measures to slow the spread of the virus in our school and to safeguard our students.

We will continue to screen the students, staff and visitors who are entering the school premises for fever and flu-like symptoms, and conduct **once - daily temperature taking**. In the event that your child displays a fever and/or flu-like symptoms, we seek your understanding to bring your child to see a doctor and rest at home.

The health needs of our students are different and schools will continue to adopt necessary precautionary measures to safeguard our students especially those susceptible to complications in health issue. We will continue issuing Leave of Absence (LOA) to all school staff and students who are in close contact with confirmed H1N1 cases. This is to reduce the risk of the spread of the virus which can be life-threatening for some of our students.

We will appreciate your efforts in reinforcing our reminders on personal hygiene and encourage your child to practise good personal hygiene at home.

Some suggestions on what you can do are:

- a. Check your child's temperature and look out for any flu-like symptoms. If your child is unwell, we seek your cooperation to exercise social responsibility by seeking medical attention for your child and ensuring that your child is well before returning to school.
- b. If your child is unwell and has been issued an MC by a doctor, it is crucial that you inform the school immediately and submit the MC to the school as soon as possible.
- c. If anyone is unwell at home, you can offer a mask to the unwell person and minimise his/her contact with your child.

We seek your cooperation and understanding in our efforts to implement these measures. We will continue to monitor the situation closely and keep you updated on new developments.
