Secondary school experience

- 1. Common curriculum subjects at lower secondary
- 2. Subjects to be offered at G1, G2 or G3, mapped from the standards of the N(T), N(A) and Express subject levels respectively
- 3. Greater flexibility to offer subjects at various subject levels
- 4. Shift away from stream-based subject offerings




